In accordance with the provisions of an act passed by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado, session 1885, entitled "an Act to amend Section IV, of Chapter XCV, of the General Statutes of the State of Colorado, entitled 'Roads and Highways'", it was ordered by the Board that all Section lines, Township lines and Range lines on the public domain east of the Range line dividing Ranges 65w. and 66w. be and the same are hereby declared Public Highways of the width of sixty feet, being thirty feet on each side of said Section lines, Township lines or Range lines, as the case may be; the same being in El Paso County, Colorado.
