Position Description:

The Survey Technician assists the survey team in the processing and verification of survey data, preparation of survey drawings, as-builts and construction stakeout deliverables, as well as creating subdivision plats, Records of Survey, Land Survey Plats and Alta Surveys.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Performs assignments designed to develop professional working knowledge and abilities, requiring the application of standard techniques, procedures, and criteria needed to carry out a sequence of related surveying tasks.
- Assumes limited degree of judgment on performing routine aspects of survey assignments.
- Responsible for creating property boundaries for roads, pipelines, facility sites, subdivisions, and other right of ways and easements by visibly marking location boundaries.
- Responsible for assisting with field operations, as needed.
- Collects information needed to carry out new surveys using source maps, previous survey data, photographs, computer records, and other relevant information.
- Compiles survey computations with applicable standards to determine adequacy of data.
- Compiles information necessary to stake projects for construction, using engineering plans.
- Proficient in understanding and complying with required safety procedures and practices; works in a safe manner and complies with all safety regulations.
- Ability to travel for short periods of time.

Supervisory Responsibilities: May mentor and train the Junior Surveyor staff.

Qualifications:

- Working knowledge of land surveying and equipment use.

- Possesses basic understanding of the principles and practices of surveying preferred.
- Possesses basic knowledge of easements and related research.
- Possesses a solid understanding of AutoCAD.
- Ability to read plans and understand boundary topography.
- Understands project schedules and budgets; is able to work efficiently within project guidelines.
